Katharine Jacobs is a professor at the University of Arizona and Director of the Center for Climate Adaptation Science and Solutions, which builds adaptation and assessment capacity at multiple scales. From 2010 – 2013, Jacobs worked in the Office of Science and Technology Policy in the White House. She was director of the Third National Climate Assessment, and the lead advisor on water science, policy, and adaptation. From 2006-2009 Jacobs was Executive Director of the Arizona Water Institute, focused on water sustainability. She worked 23 years as an Arizona water manager, and was director of the Tucson Active Management Area from 1988 through 2001. She earned her M.L.A. in environmental planning from Berkeley and her BA in Biology from Middlebury College.
