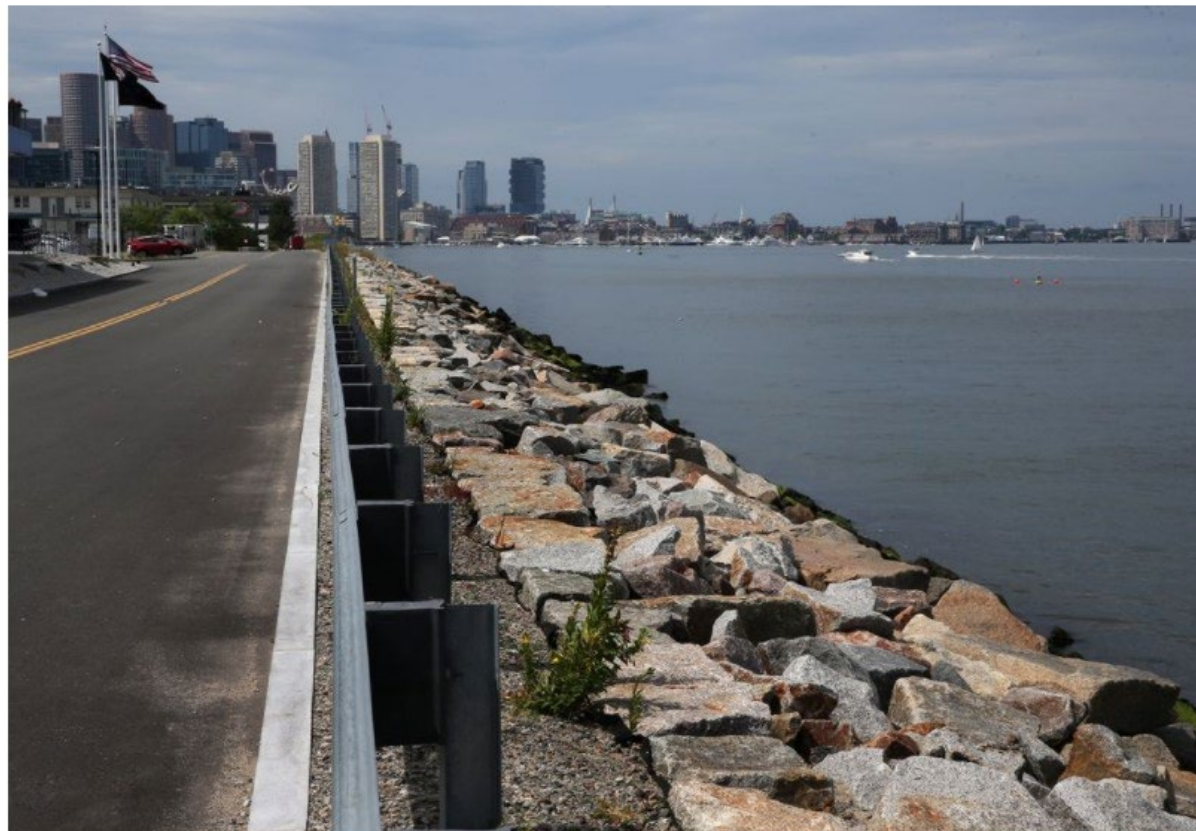

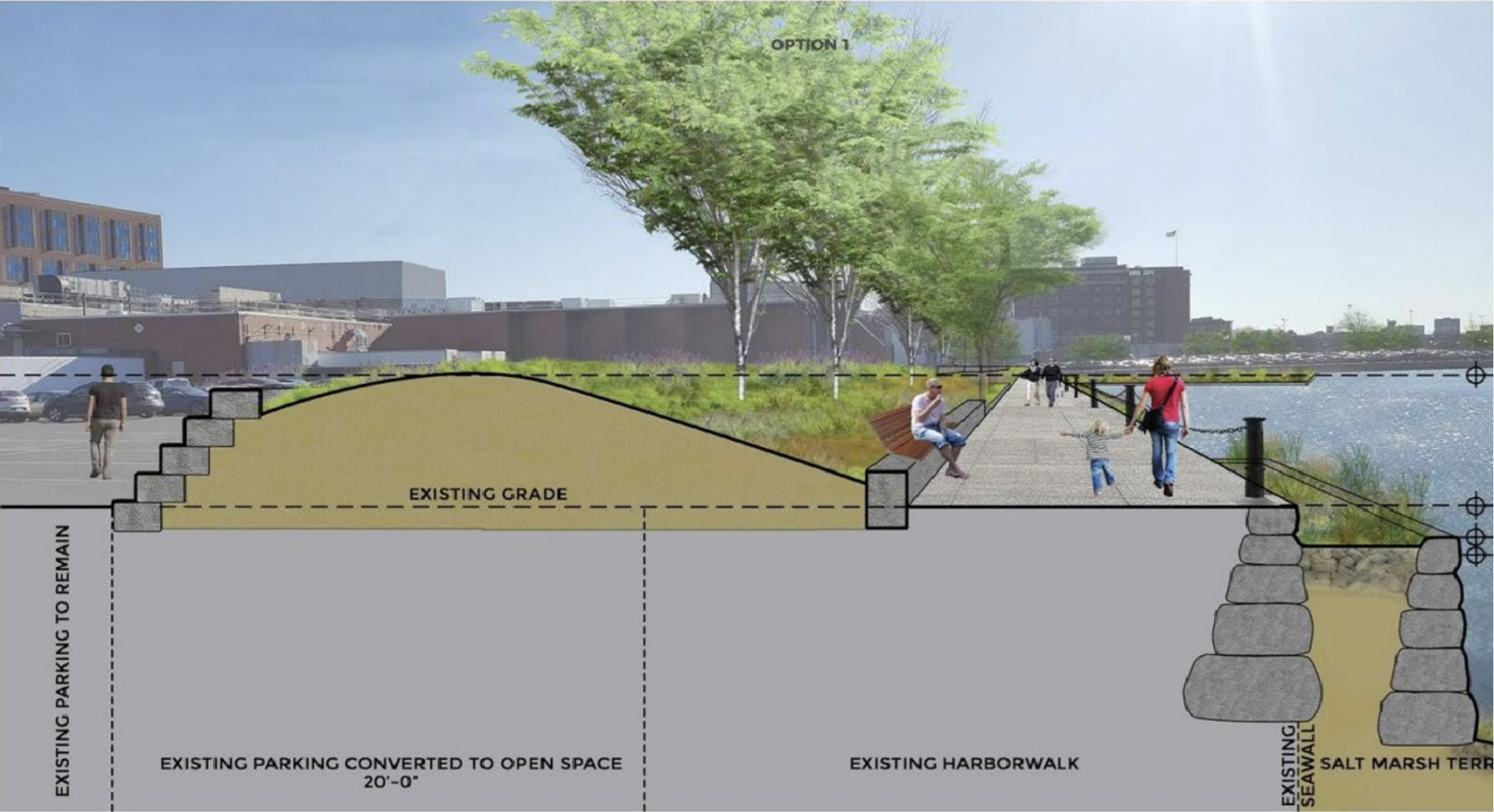
The program will ask developers to help fund a sea wall to protect the city's Marine Industrial Park from rising seas

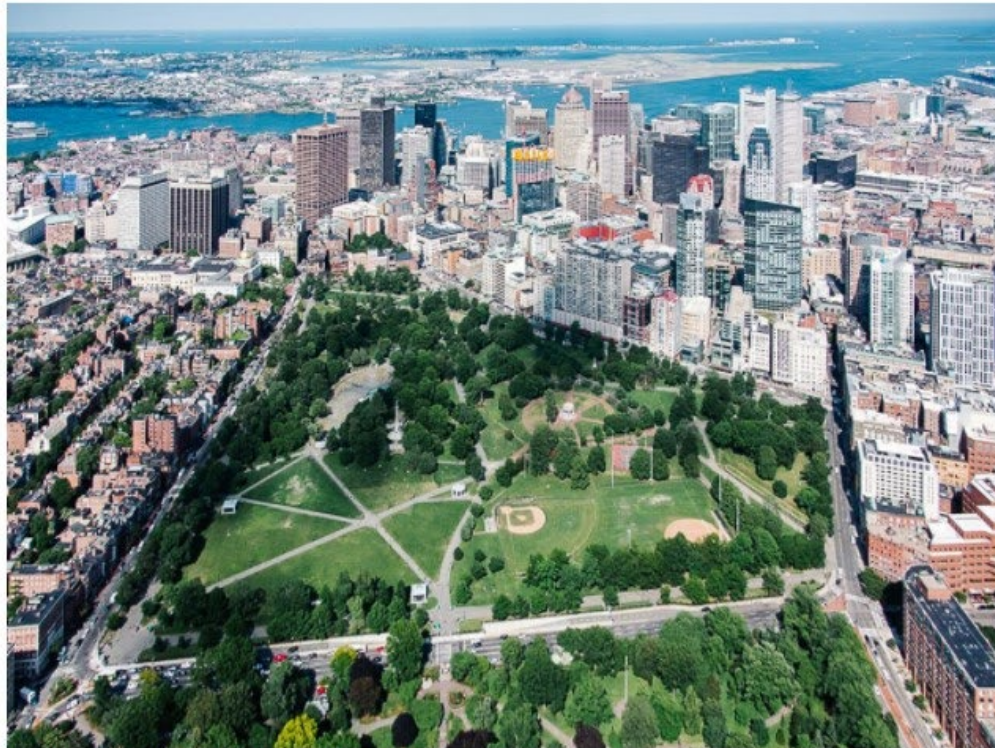
